

<u>QUINONES</u>—He made 2018 <u>PrepStar All-Western Region</u> and Honolulu Star-Advertiser All-State first team as a senior defensive lineman at Saint Louis School in Honolulu (Hi.). He also played basketball at Saint Louis.

SLOVIS—He made 2018 PrepStar All-Western Region and Sports360AZ All-Academic honorable mention as a senior quarterback at Desert Mountain High in Scottsdale (Ariz.). He completed 183-of-294 passes (62.2%) for 2,542 yards with 18 TDs and 6 interceptions in 2018. As a junior in 2017, he made USA Today All-Arizona honorable mention as he completed 251-of-392 passes (64.0%) for 2,987 yards and 32 TDs with 5 interceptions. His quarterbacks coach at Desert Mountain was NFL Hall of Famer Kurt Warner.

TA'UFO'OU—He made 2018 PrepStar All-Western Region and All-Camino League Defensive Lineman of the Year as a senior linebacker and running back at Grace Brethren High in Simi Valley (Calif.). In 2018, he had 97 tackles, including 17 for losses (with 9.5 sacks), 6 forced fumbles, a fumble recovery and a deflection on defense, ran for 166 yards on 24 carries (11.1 avg) with 2 TD and had a 12-yard reception on offense and had a 16-yard kickoff return. Grace Brethern won the 2018 state 2AA and CIF Division 4 titles. As a junior in 2017, he made Cal-Hi Sports All-State Medium Schools first team, Cal-Hi Sports Juniors third team, All-CIF Division 8 Player of the Year and All-Tri-Valley

first team as he had 89 tackles, including 10 sacks, plus an interception for a TD, 3 fumble recoveries, a forced fumble and a deflection on defense and ran for 35 yards on 10 carries (3.5 avg) and caught 2 passes for 33 yards (16.5 avg) on offense.

WILLIAMS—He made 2018 PrepStar Dream Team as a senior cornerback and wide receiver at Serra High in Gardena (Calif.). He suffered torn knee ligaments in the 2018 season opener and was sidelined the rest of the year. As a junior in 2017, he made Cal-Hi Sports All-State Juniors first team, All-CIF Division 1 and South Bay Daily Breeze All-South Bay first team as he had 27 tackles, 7 deflections, 3 interceptions (2 for TDs), 2 blocked field goals, a fumble recovery (for a TD) and a forced fumble on defense, caught 16 passes for 150 yards (9.4 avg) on offense and returned 16 punts (1 for a TD) for 266 yards (16.6 avg) and 15 kickoffs for 305 yards (20.3 avg). As a 2016 sophomore, he made the Cal-Hi Sports All-State Sophomores first team, All-CIF Division 1, South Bay Daily Breeze All-South Bay first team and All-Mission League first team as he had 24 tackles, 4 deflections and 2 interceptions along with 25 receptions for 278 yards (11.1 avg) with 2 TDs and a punt return for a TD. As a 2015 freshman, he made Max Preps Freshman All-American first team as he had 34 tackles, 4 deflections and 3 interceptions, plus caught a 25-yard pass. He also sprinted for Serra's track team (he led off the CIF Division 4 championship 400-meter relay team).

WOLFE—He made 2018 PrepStar All-American as a senior tight end at St. John Bosco in Bellflower (Calif.). He had 14 catches for 225 yards (16.1 avg) with 7 TDs in 2018. As a junior in 2017, he had 9 receptions for 113 yards (12.6 avg) with 3 TDs. As a 2016 sophomore, he had a 21-yard catch. He also played basketball at St. John Bosco. His father, Mark, played football at Western Michigan (1977-80). His brother, Jakob, was a tight end at Stony Brook (2014). His sister, Jacqueline, played volleyball at Hawaii Pacific (2015). His cousin, Ryan Gutierrez, was a safety at California (2001-04).

CHRISTON—He made 2018 PrepStar All-Western Region and All-CIF San Diego first team as senior running back and cornerback at Madison High in San Diego (Calif.). He ran for 980 yards on 127 carries (7.7 avg) with 11 TD and caught 9 passes for 122 yards (13.6 avg) with 1 TD in 2018. As a junior in 2017, he made All-CIF San Diego second team as he ran for 1,233 yards on 111 carries (11.1 avg) with 16 TDs and caught 6 passes for 107 yards (17.8 avg) with 1 TD. As a 2016 sophomore, he rushed for 829 yards on 100 carries (8.3 avg) with 9 TDs, caught 3 passes for 29 yards (9.7 avg) with 1 TD, returned 13 kickoffs for 330 yards (25.4 avg) with 1 TD and made 6 tackles.

<u>DAVIS</u>—A knee injury forced him to miss most of his 2018 senior season but he made <u>PrepStar All-Western Region</u> at cornerback at Federal Way (Wash.) High. He had 30 tackles, including 8 for a loss, as a 2017 junior. He also ran track at Federal Way, with a best of 10.94 in the 100 meters and 22.73 in the 200 meters. He helped the 400-meter relay team win the 2018 State 4A title. His full first name is Treyvon.

<u>LIVAI</u>—He made **2018 PrepStar All-Western Region** as a senior offensive lineman at Narbonne High in Harbor City (Calif.). He previously played at Hilo (Hi.) High, where as a 2017 junior he made **All-Big Island Scholastic Federation** and helped Hilo win the Hawaii Division 1 state championship. He also was on Hilo's track team (shot put and discus throw).

LONDON—He made 2018 PrepStar All-American and All-Camino League Co-Wide Receiver of the Year as a senior wide receiver at Moorpark (Calif.) High. He had 62 catches for 1,089 yards (17.6 avg) with 12 TDs in 2018. As a junior in 2017, he made Cal-Hi Sports All-State Juniors third team, All-CIF Division 5 and Los Angeles Daily News All-Area second team as he had 51 receptions for 1,032 yards (20.2 avg) with 11 TDs, plus he rushed 5 times for 123 yards (24.6 avg) and threw a 14-yard TD pass. He also played basketball at Moorpark. He averaged 19.8 points, 11.1 rebounds and 3.9 assists as a 2018 junior.

McCLAIN—He made 2018 PrepStar All-Western Region as a senior wide receiver at JSerra Catholic High in San Juan Capistrano (Calif.). He had 40 receptions for 659 yards (16.5 avg) with 10 TDs in 2018, although he missed the first half of the season while recovering from a 2017 knee injury. As a junior in 2017, he caught 19 passes for 390 yards (20.5 avg) with 4 TDs and also had an 11-yard kickoff return before suffering a mid-season knee injury. He also played basketball at JSerra. His brother, Abdul-Malik, is a redshirt freshman outside linebacker at USC. His first name is pronounced "mooNEER."

<u>RAE</u>—He made **2018 PrepStar All-American** as a senior tight end at Orange (Calif.) Lutheran High. He had 7 catches for 58 yards (8.3 avg) on offense and 19 tackles and 2 fumble recoveries on defense in 2018. He was sidelined as a 2017 junior with a torn knee ligament. He spent his 2016 sophomore season at Servite High in Anaheim (Calif.), getting 13 catches for 192 yards (14.8 avg) with 2 TDs. He also played basketball and baseball at Servite.

RODRIGUEZ—He made 2018 PrepStar Dream Team and All-Mojave River League first team as a senior offensive and defensive tackle at Oak Hills (Calif.) High. As a junior in 2017, he made Cal-Hi Sports All-State Juniors second team, All-CIF Division 3, San Bernardino Sun-Inland Valley Daily Bulletin All-Area and All-Mojave River League first team. He also was on the basketball and track (shot put, discus throw) teams at Oak Hills.

<u>TUFONO</u>—He made 2018 PrepStar Dream Team and Honolulu Star-Advertiser All-State second team as a senior inside linebacker at Punahou School in Honolulu (Hi.). As a junior in 2017, he made USA Today All-Hawaii second team. He also played basketball at Punahou. His father, Albert, played inside linebacker at Washington (1983-84, 1987), while his brother, Jack, is a sophomore offensive lineman at Idaho State. His name is pronounced "man-ee-NO-uh too-FOE-no."
