Consensus top-50 player from California according to the recruiting services ... In addition to ranking No. 14 in California by Rivals, is the No. 29 player in the state by 247Sports, No. 38 by 247 Composite rankings and No. 45 by ESPN ... No. 4 athlete in California by ESPN ... **Named a Prepstar Top 150 Dream Teamer with a No. 144 overall ranking** ... Three-year letterman and a team captain senior year ... In three seasons, combined to catch 148 passes for 2,491 yards and 31 TDs ... Finished with 11 career 100-yard receiving games ... Caught a TD pass in 21 of 37 career games, including nine games with multiple touchdown catches ... Also returned three kickoffs and one punt for touchdowns ... Named first-team All-Trinity League as both a junior and a senior ... As a senior, helped lead team to the 2019 Open Division State Championship and the Southern Section Division 1 Championship ... Had 69 receptions for 1,291 yards and 15 touchdowns with a kick return TD in 13 games ... In the Open Division State Championship Game, had seven receptions for 133 yards and a 20-yard TD catch ... Caught a season-high nine passes for 111 yards and a TD in a 31-8 win over Our Lady of Good Counsel ... Finished with five catches for a season-high 161 yards and two touchdowns in a 56-10 win over Santa Margarita ... Had 144 yards and two TDs in a 63-6 win over Orange Lutheran ... Opened the season with five catches for 139
