Daniel Bridge-Gadd • QB • 6-3 / 191 • Phoenix, Ariz. (Paradise Valley)

The Gatorade Player of the Year for the state of Arizona as a senior in 2015 ... named to the All-Arizona (all levels) first team at quarterback ... the Arizona Republic's Big Schools Player of the Year in 2015 ... named Division III Player of the Year and all-state quarterback by scout.com ... completed 251-of-374 passes for 4,258 yards and 47 touchdowns with just nine interceptions while also rushing for 627 yards and 17 touchdowns on 139 carries last fall, where Paradise Valley suffered its lone defeat of the season (29-27 to Desert Edge) ... career-high seven TDs and 512 yards passing in a state playoff win over Catalina Foothills ... also had three five-TD games as a senior, throwing at least one scoring pass in all 14 games and three or more in 10 of 14 ... as a junior, completed 171-of-265 pass attempts for 2,740 yards, 41 touchdowns and nine interceptions while also rushing for 587 yards and five TDs on 123 carries ... threw a TD in every game in 2014, including six vs. Arcadia and five against Horizon ... Trojans went 10-2 his junior year, advancing to the state tournament quarterfinals ... as a sophomore in 2013, went 236-for-345 for 2,410 yards, 27 touchdowns and 12 interceptions ... 247sports.com's No. 63 pro-style quarterback and No. 15 recruit in Arizona ... **named to the PrepStar All-West Region team** ... also played basketball and ran track at Paradise Valley ... played football for coach Greg Davis.

First-team All-District 10-5A and first-team All-Collin County at wide receiver as a senior in 2015 ... also second-team All-Collin County as a return specialist ... played receiver and cornerback for the Leopards ... team went 8-4 and advanced to the second round of the 5A D2 playoffs in 2015 ... as a senior, caught 86 passes for 1,178 yards and 14 touchdowns while also rushing for two other scores and returning two punts for touchdowns ... as a junior in 2014, had 69 receptions for 1,396 yards and 22 touchdowns, while also adding two rushing TDs and another on a punt return ... named the District 10-5A Offensive Player of the Year, earning that honor unanimously ... also All-Collin County and Associated Press first-team 5A all-state as a junior in 2014 ... the Leopards made it into the first round of the state playoffs in 2014 ... as a sophomore, had 26 catches for 447 yards and five scores, earning second-team All-District 13-4A ... team went 8-4 and advanced to the second round of the 5A D2 state playoffs in 2013 ... also saw action on the varsity as a freshman ... **a PrepStar All-Midlands Region selection** ... ran the 100, 200 and 400 meters and also participated in long jump ... won district and area titles in the 400 meters as a junior ... played football under coach Ryan Cox.

Helped Wolverines to an 11-2 record and a berth in the 3A state championship game as a senior in 2015 ... had three interceptions in the state semifinal game ... named to MaxPreps.com Medium-Sized Schools All-America second team as a defensive back ... also first-team 3A All-KingCo, first-team Seattle Times all-state (all levels), Associated Press 3A all-state and Tacoma News Tribune all-area ... earned a spot on the All-USA Western Washington first team as a defensive back ... caught four passes as a senior,

the USA Today final poll following the 2015 season ... named first-team All-Big VIII League in 2015 ... as a junior in 2014, helped lead Centennial to a 13-3 overall record, the Pac 5 Division championship and a spot in the Open Division state championship game ... team was ranked in USA Today final top 25 ... as a sophomore in 2013, helped the Huskies to a 12-3 overall record, the CIF Southern Section Inland Division championship and the semifinals of the Open Division state championships ... named **PrepStar All-West Region** ... named to the Tacoma News Tribune "Western 100" ... rivals.com's No. 24 cornerback in the country and No. 53 recruit in California ...made scout.com's top 300 (at No. 254), as well as the No. 21 corner ... according to ESPN, the No. 28 cornerback in the nation and the No. 54 overall prospect in California ... 247sports.com's No. 39 cornerback in the country and No. 51 recruit in California ... played for coach Matt Logan.

Sean McGrew • TB • 5-7 / 173 • Torrance, Calif. (St. John Bosco)

Named the Gatorade Player of the Year for the state of California following the 2015 season ... during his four-year career, rushed for 5,762 yards on 630 carries (a 9.1-yard average), with 76 career rushing TDs, as well as nine career receiving touchdowns ... never lost a Trinity League game during his career ... in 2015, named to the MaxPreps.com All-America second team (all levels) as a running back ... CalHiSports.com's first-team all-state ... also earned Long Beach Press-Telegram Player of the Year, Los Angeles Times all-area first team and first-team CIF Southern Section All-Pac 5 Division ... as a senior, rushed for 1,852 yards and 27 touchdowns on 200 carries, while also catching 17 passes for 264 yards and three scores ... the 2015 Bosco squad spent much of the year ranked No. 1 in the nation and finished 13-1, falling only to Centennial in the CIF Southern Section Pac 5 Division championship game ... ranked No. 11 in the final USA Today poll in 2015 ... McGrew rushed for 184 yards and three TDs in that title game ... named to the All-CIF Southern Section Pac-5 Division first team, Long Beach Press-Telegram Dream Team and the Trinity League Offensive MVP as a junior ... first-team junior all-state from CalHiSports.com ... as a junior, had 224 carries for 1,814 yards and 28 scores, along with 19 catches for 312 yards and four more TDs ...
